Which countires spend the most and least time on screens

PHILIPPINES:

“The Philippines has been named as the country who use the internet the most, with people spending an average of 10 hours a day online,” this is surprising because the Philippines is not one of the most developed countries(“New Study Reveals Countries Most Addicted to their screens”).

JAPAN:

Japan spends the least amount of time online, averaging around 4 hours a day (“New Study Reveals Countries Most Addicted to their screens”). This is less than half of the Philippines use.

UNITED STATES:

The United States averages six and a half hours of internet use per day (“New Study Reveals Countries Most Addicted to their screens”). This is very close to the global average.

WORLD AVERAGE:

The worldwide average internet use per day is 6 hours and 42 minutes (“New Study Reveals Countries Most Addicted to their screens”). This number is much higher than it should be.

RESULTS:

As seen the United States is about average in screen use compared to the rest of the world. While the Phillippines have the highest average screen use and Japan having the lowest, Japan is a more technology-oriented country than the Philippines. So this leads to the question of how race affects screen usage.



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
